

PRIVACY POLICY NEWSLETTERS

Your privacy is important to us.

For our newsletters, we only collect and use your personal data in accordance with applicable data protection legislation, in particular the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (“GDPR”), as well as this privacy policy.

2. PURPOSE

For our newsletters, we process your personal identification data (name, (company) address, e-mail address), personal characteristics (gender, language) and education or employment data (position, company). We may also receive information about your interaction with our newsletters.

We obtain this personal data directly from you.

We will send you our newsletters up to 10 years plus a verification period of 1 year after the closing of the (last) case with you as a client. You can of course unsubscribe to our newsletters at any time (for more information, see **Error! Reference source not found.**).

Our suppliers of marketing tools and IT providers also have access to your personal data.

3. SECURITY

We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the confidentiality of your personal data and to protect your data from accidental and unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure and access.

We have made the necessary contractual arrangements with the third parties with whom we work together and will not transfer your personal data outside the European Economic Area without ensuring that your data is granted an equivalent level of protection there.

4. RIGHTS

You can always contact us to exercise the following rights:

- the right to access or rectification of your personal data
- the right to erasure of your personal data
- the right to restrict of the processing of your personal data
- the right to object to the processing of your data
- the right to transmit your data to another service provider
- a complaint if you believe that we are not acting in accordance with applicable data protection laws. You can also submit a complaint to the Belgian Data Protection Authority.
